AFTER HOURS SWIMMING POOL RENTAL APPLICATION

All Fees must be paid when submitting the application. Tax is included in the fee.

Subject to the rules and regulations of the Division of Natural Resources, I enclose \$ _____, which represents the total rental, for reservation of swimming pool of the type listed below:

RATE CALCULATION BASED UPON NUMBER OF PEOPLE: Please be sure to correctly indicate the number of people at pool rental. Safety is of upmost concern to our pool patrons, if your group exceeds the number of people listed on this application, the additional people will be prohibited from entering the pool area. Beech Fork State Park is required to follow pool lifeguard to number of patron’s guidelines to remain open per Title 64 Legislative Rule for Bureau for Public Health, Series 16 Recreational Water Facilities.

In the event of inclement weather, power outage or other unusual situation that leads to pool closure, a full refund will be given.

AFTER HOUR POOL RENTAL GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Any changes in reservation times, which may increase the number of lifeguards needed, are required a minimum 14 days before rental. All changes in rates must be immediately paid in full and are subject to lifeguard and pool availability.
2. If you are using the facility during normal business hours and have an “afterhours” reservation the same day, you will need to vacate pool area at closing time. This allows the pool staff to perform any needed maintenance and give the staff preparation time for your event. Your group will be allowed to enter at the assigned time of 6:30pm to begin your event.
3. Reservation time period must include all set-up, decoration and clean up time. The facility must be promptly vacated at the time specified on the application.
4. Individual renting the facility will be held responsible for any loss or damage caused during rental.
5. All pool rules posted at the facility must be adhered to. Failure to do so could result in cancellation of the event.
6. The Division of Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation section reserves the right to reject applications of those whose actions in previous years did not conform to regulations. Any person or group of persons may be evicted by the lifeguard or other state employee for failure to conform to area regulations and guidelines.
7. The concession stand will not be open during after hour pool rentals. You may bring your own food and drink. Glass containers are prohibited. There is no storage space available to refrigerate/freeze any items.
8. If thunder or lightning is heard or seen, all patrons will be evacuated from the water and will wait in the locker room or bathroom areas. Patrons will only return to the deck or in the pool if 30 minutes has elapsed since the last thunder or lightening. Such delays are not refundable.

Swimming Pool Rules

§58-33-2

Rules Governing Public Use of Swimming Areas in State Parks, State Forests, and State Wildlife Management Areas under the Division of Natural Resources.

Any person may be denied to the swimming area that has a skin abrasion, cold, cough, inflamed eye, infection, rash, bandage or cast. Admission shall be denied by the area superintendent to any person who is under the influence of alcohol, a controlled substance or medication.

Plastic or rubber rafts, inner tubes, balls, inflatable water wings, and similar paraphernalia, toys and manmade objects of any kind are prohibited within the swimming area, except that exceptions may be made for the handicapped and for organized activities at the discretion of the lifeguard in charge.

No person is permitted in a swimming pool unless he or she is dressed in recognized swimming apparel. No street wear, cutoffs or similar apparel may be worn in a swimming pool. Parents and guardians may enter the swimming area in street clothes to accompany and supervise their children who have not reached their twelfth (12th) birthday. Parents and guardians who enter the swimming area and are not dressed in recognized swimming apparel are prohibited from entering the water.

The wearing of indecent swimming or other apparel, the commission of any indecent act, and the commission of any act of indecent exposure are prohibited in the swimming area. Commission of any such act is cause for immediate eviction from the swimming area.

Only one (1) person is permitted on a diving board at a time. Running, pushing, wrestling, roughhousing or causing undue disturbance, noise or commotion is prohibited in the swimming area.

Only state employees or other authorized personnel are permitted behind counters where cash registers are located, behind concession stand counters, or in concession stand food storage areas, basket rooms, swimming area storage supply rooms, filtration rooms or chlorine rooms.

Every person entering a swimming area shall comply with all swimming rules and every instruction or directive of the lifeguards. Any person who fails to comply may be evicted immediately from the swimming area by a lifeguard or other state employee. Any person evicted forfeits the fee he or she paid to enter the swimming area.

No refunds may be given for any reason to any person who leaves the swimming area.

§58-33-3.

Enforcement of Rules Governing Public Use of Swimming Areas in State Parks, State Forests, and Recreation Areas in State Wildlife Management Areas under the Division of Natural Resources and Penalties.

Responsibility for enforcing the rules.

It is the duty and responsibility of Natural Resources Police Officers, Special Natural Resources Police Officers, and the superintendents, assistant superintendents and managers of state parks, state forests, and state wildlife management areas to enforce all of the provisions of this rule.

Violation of rules and penalties.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this rule is guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished in accordance with W. Va. Code '20-7-9.
